

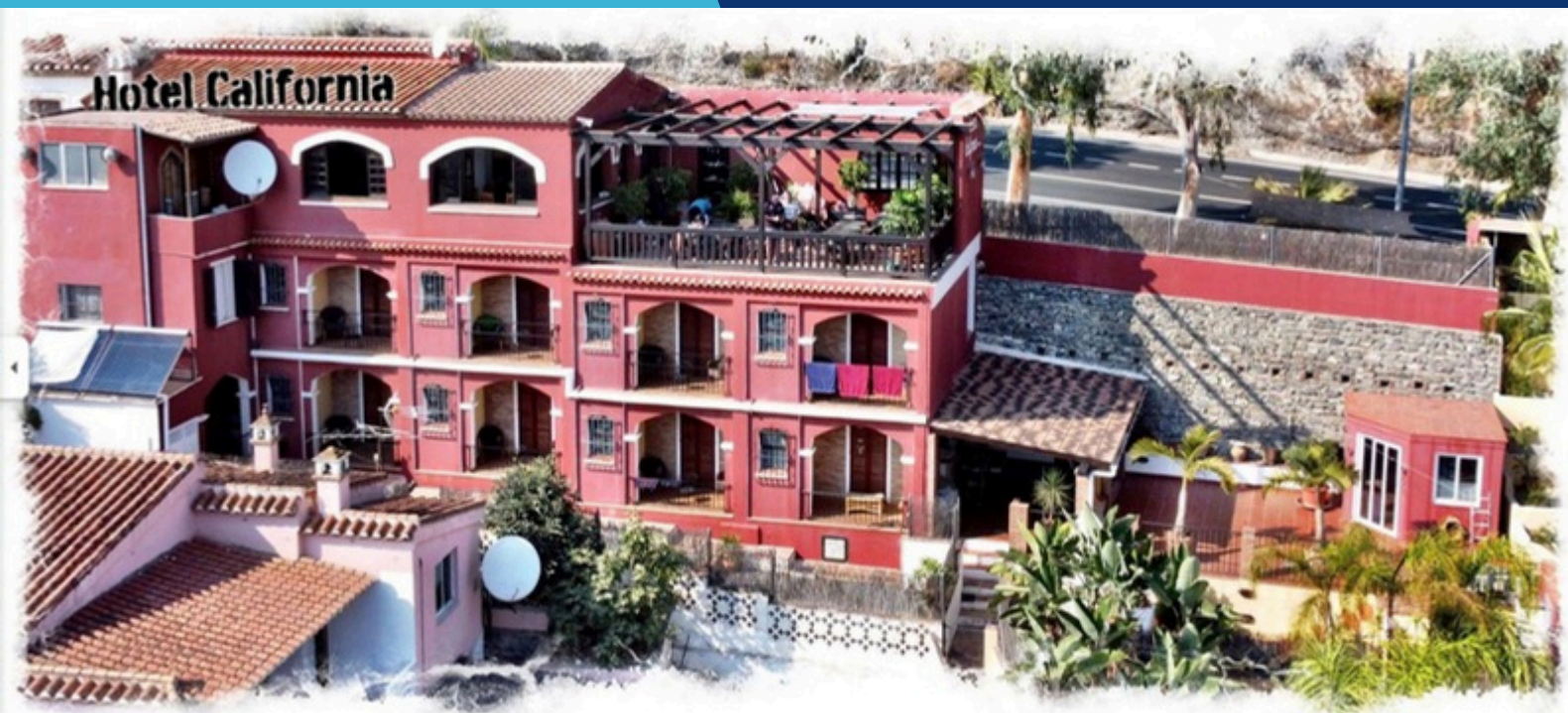

Our Challenge

As missionaries to Spain, two large challenges lie before us: A lack of discipleship for young Christian believers, and a nation that is largely unreached with the gospel. It is estimated that less than 2% of Spain is evangelical Christian, and although this number is on the rise, a great portion of this percentage is comprised of Latino believers who have relocated to Spain. There are very few indigenous, Spanish local churches, and fewer Spanish pastors to lead them.

Unfortunately, the time and costs associated with obtaining a traditional seminary degree and missionary training are prohibitive for most young people – especially Spaniards. This nation is still struggling with recession and unemployment, particularly among those under 25 years old. Something must be done to reach this nation and the world with the message of Jesus.

The Solutions



The Discipleship Training School (DTS) and Bible Core Course (BCC) - preparing young people for mission and service

Our DTS is a five-month, full-time university-level program in which the first three months include theological and practical training, and the final two months are a national and international practicum where we have a focus on helping children at risk and aid to refugees.

Our DTS costs around \$6,500 for tuition, room and board, and travel expenses during the entire 5 months.

The Bible Core Course is a three-month intensive study of God's Word using the inductive method, where individuals learn to become life-long students of the Bible.

Our schools are financially self-supporting; however, the lack of a permanent campus requires us to limit enrollment and creates persistent logistical difficulties in securing housing for staff and students due to the competitive beach-town rental market.



Community Outreach - meeting practical needs in our neighborhood

Part of our school schedule includes weekly outreach in our city.

We regularly teach values to children in the public parks and beaches, and have periodic invitations to go into the public school with our curriculum-- teaching topics like anti-bullying, respect, honesty, forgiveness, kindness, and wisdom.

We have led food bank initiatives, taught English and parenting classes, and collaborated with local government in city improvement projects and cultural events.

Our urgent need for a building

Because we live in a beach town, it is challenging to rent houses for staff and students on a year-round basis. Most landlords allow seasonal rent only, since they can charge triple the price on short-term vacation rentals during the summer or holidays.

We need a permanent home for our YWAM campus!

We have found a 5,307 sq. ft. hotel for sale that has 10 large bedrooms (each with its own bathroom), two commercial kitchens, and multiple dining and common areas. With bunks, we can house up to **40** people on-site! It has balconies and terraces, and is partially powered by solar panels, reducing our electricity costs. The hotel comes fully furnished and is updated with many modern amenities. It is move-in ready, and with some minor upgrades will meet our current needs. A further bonus is that it has 10 private parking spaces, which is a HUGE benefit in our crowded town. It is strategically located in the the city, close to parks, the beach, and community life.

In a future construction phase, this hotel can be expanded to add additional bedrooms and a worship hall. **This facility will increase our outreach capacity in Spain and internationally.**

Price

This hotel has been for sale several years, and the price has dropped from \$1.4 million to \$1.1 million. The owners love who we are and what we do. In fact, the mother of the seller (a devout Christian) is praying that WE are the ones to purchase it so the building can be used for ministry. We have already raised over \$350,000- and in **December 2025, all donations are being matched to double the impact of each gift!**



People

The next Discipleship Training School begins in February and we have an urgent need to house students and families in a central location -- not in rented apartments scattered all over the city. In recent schools, we have resorted to a waiting list for applicants due to a lack of space. **In 2025 alone, we have turned down 54 volunteers** wishing to serve with us because our limited housing with our current facility. As an added bonus, the income from staff and students, visiting teams, and guests will not only cover all of the operational expenses of the building, but will also generate funds for expanded ministry.



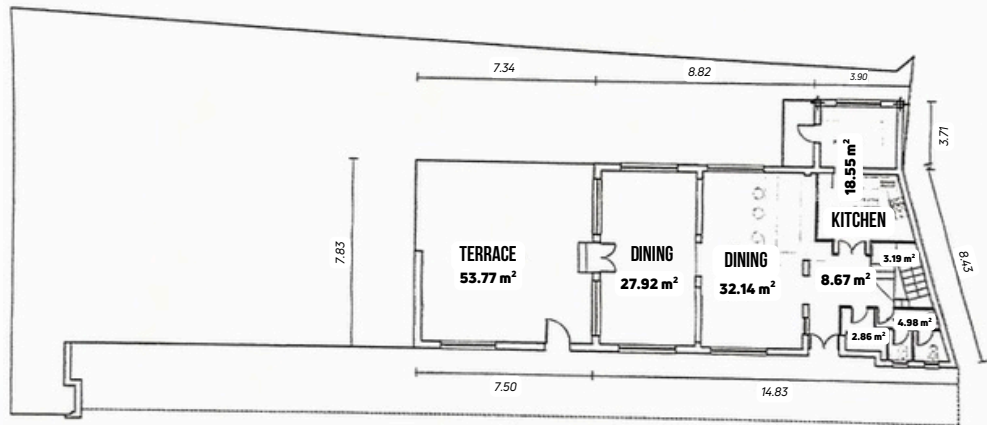
Community

Owning a highly visible property in the town establishes us and gives credibility to our mission. This purchase will free up resources and allow us to rent a public space in the city center where we can offer pre-evangelism classes such as English, art, fitness, parenting, after-school assistance, and children's programs for our neighbors and community as a way to build meaningful relationships which point them to Jesus.

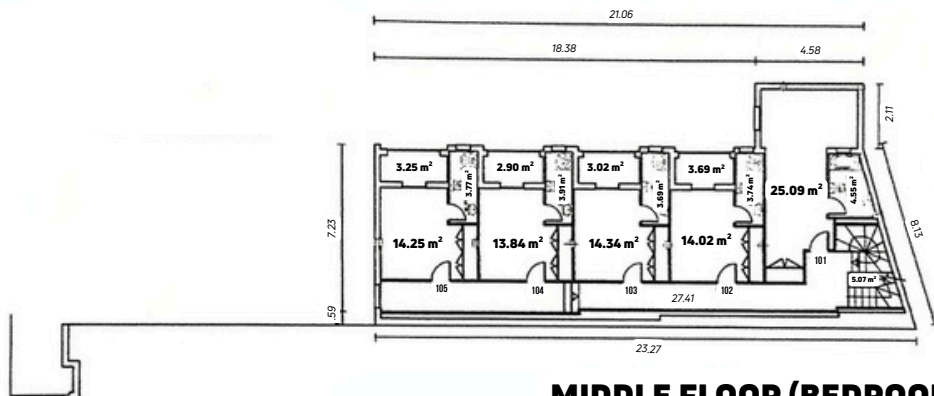

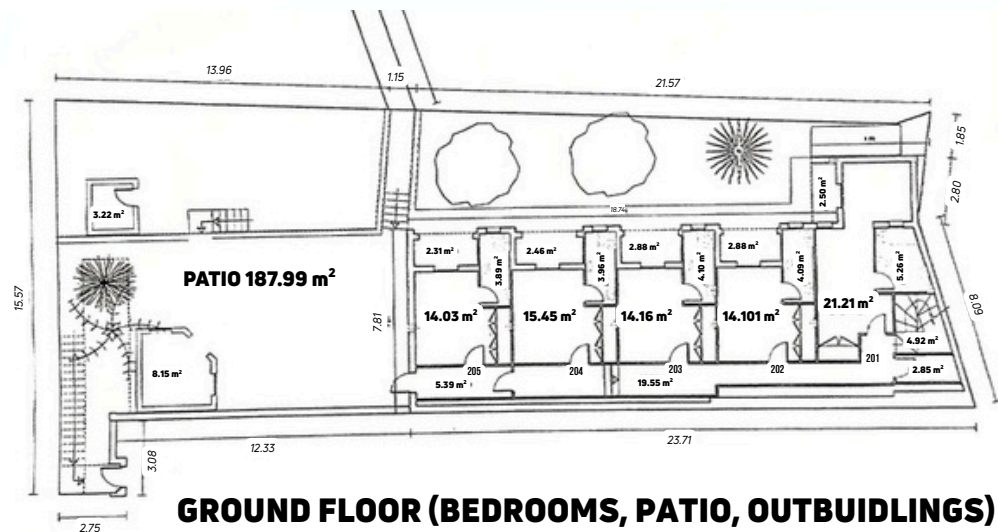
Floor plans

Our story



Justin and Angela Secrist met in Madrid in 1999 during their DTS. They married in 2002 and have been on an adventure with God ever since. They served as youth pastors for five years before joining YWAM full-time in Madrid, Spain in 2012.

Justin has a B.A. degree in Spanish from Western Washington University and a Masters in Ministry degree (MIM) from Northwest University and is ordained with the Assemblies of God. He enjoys family, unicycling, hiking, and being outdoors.

Angela has a B.A. degree in Elementary Education and is passionate about teaching and mentoring. Her hobbies include fitness, healthy cooking, art, and sea kayaking.

Both share a passion for missions, discipleship, children and young adult ministries and are fluent in Spanish. They have two children, Micah and Melody.

In January of 2020 they were commissioned to pioneer a new YWAM campus in Almuñécar, Granada, on the southern Coast of Spain. They have built a team of 14 adults (with 13 kids!) representing eight nationalities. They have led eight Discipleship Training Schools, discipling 67 students from 23 nations.

YWAM Costa Tropical is a registered non-profit in Spain, governed by statutes and bylaws and accountable to both national and international leadership.

YWAM Costa Tropical operates under audited oversight structures within YWAM Spain, adheres to nonprofit financial standards, and maintains transparent reporting for all designated gifts. All funds given toward the acquisition will be used exclusively for securing a ministry property. Detailed documentation is available upon request.

Major Ministry Milestones

- January 2018 - Justin Secrist leads first DTS outreach team to Almuñécar, Spain.
- January 2020 - Our pioneering team commissioned from Madrid to establish a new YWAM campus.
- March 2020 - Global Pandemic creates opportunity to partner with a local church to open and manage a food bank which feeds over 100 people over the next 18 months.
- July 2021 - "Kids on the beach" ministry launches. Later expands into "Kids in the park."
- September 2021 - First Discipleship Training School in Almuñécar.
- September 2022 - First "family friendly" DTS.
- September 2023 - First Bible Core Course.
- October 2023 - First "Fall Fest" cultural event on October 31 at the city park with 600 attendees.
- Summer 2024 - We receive and host three evangelism outreach teams.
- November 2024 - Our team teaches "Creation conference" for children.
- February 2025 - Second family-friendly DTS.
- April 2025 - "Día de la familia" (Family day) to strengthen and support local families.
- September 2025 - Angela Secrist launches "Love and Logic" parenting seminar.

Also known as **YWAM** (pronounced “WHY-wham”), we unite in a common purpose to know God and to make Him known. Founded by Loren Cunningham in 1960, the main focus was to help youth get involved in missions. Today, YWAM includes people of all ages. We currently have tens of thousands of staff from nearly every country on earth.

what we do

With established ministries in 180+ nations, three purposes guide us: *Evangelism, Training and Mercy Ministry*. These influence every sphere of society, including refugee relief, anti-trafficking, medical care, Bible training, business coaching, education, performing arts, sports ministries, government, and more.

YWAM functions as a family of ministries rather than a centralized agency. Our location, **YWAM Costa Tropical** in Granada is one of 13 campuses in Spain.

Frequently Asked Questions

Why not build on or renovate a cheaper property or look for something less expensive in the countryside?

We are called to be missionaries, not construction workers. Immersing ourselves in a building project would sacrifice time and resources from ministry. Our heart and passion is to be in the heart of the city, living among the people to share God's love. The key to reaching Spain for Jesus is developing meaningful relationships, and these take time and trust.

It's true that a hotel seems like a lot to start with, but God has clearly told us to dream big and not attempt what is only humanly possible. This way ALL will see and know of God's miraculous hand.

What happens to my donation if you aren't able to get the hotel?

All money donated to the purchase of this property will go toward purchasing a YWAM building. If for some reason we are unable to meet the deadlines or this property is sold to another, then the funds will purchase another property. Once we commit the required 10% deposit, that portion becomes non-refundable.



"Before I came to Spain I didn't believe God loved me. As a child I suffered traumas and I especially felt abandoned by my father. During my DTS God spoke into these areas, and showed me how much He loved me. He showed me that He, as my heavenly Father, never had abandoned or forsaken me and that He had seen the pain I had suffered and that He'd cried over it.

Now the Lord sends me to nations to tell traumatized children, teenagers and young adults that they are loved by God, that He sees them and that He cares about what they are going through."

Frequently Asked Questions

Can you run the hotel as a business and make money?

As a registered non-profit, we can collect "donations" from people who stay in our building, but to operate as a business in Spain opens the door to significant tax responsibilities and would not be self-sustaining.

Is it possible to get a mortgage on this property?

Obtaining a mortgage in the name of YWAM is difficult, though not impossible. However, God has clearly shown us that in this situation, a mortgage would be doing things the human way. We are believing in faith that our story must be a miracle and done God's way.

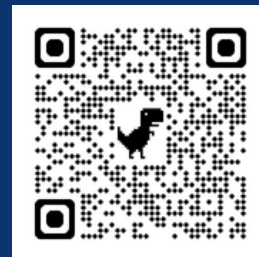
